Date: School is in session primarily mid-August through the end of November and February through mid-May. We have short term class in June and July – but no families then.

What would I do? You would come to encourage the students, their families, and the faculty. This can be done through teaching, children’s ministry, providing rest and relaxation opportunities, and improving the classrooms and the hostels where they live. When you come out to visit, you would be able to see some of the needs we have at the College and meet our wonderful faculty and students.

Requirements: If teaching a class you would need theological education, but to help the women and children you wouldn’t need anything but love.

Maximum number of people that can come on a team? 4. Adults only because of security issues.

Approximate cost per day per person? \$30 a day. Lodging \$20 per room at the Baptist Guest House. Food – about \$10 a day if you eat at the guesthouse. You would need a driver and vehicle for transport to and from Abuja where you would need to fly into Nigeria which would be about \$160 each way for a van. For a group of 4, sharing 2 rooms that would be about \$30 a day, not counting the Abuja trips, which would be an additional one time cost of \$120 each including overnight stay in Abuja both ways per person plus transportation from/to airport in Abuja.
